

Campground Rules

- ALL GUESTS** must register upon arrival and obtain a car pass. All cars must have a car tag visible.
- CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT TIMES** : RV & Tent Sites: Check in: 2pm, Check-out: 12pm. Please remove trash.
- QUIET HOURS** – 10pm – 8am. Loud and excessive noise is not acceptable at any time. Generator hours: 8am – 10pm.
- SPEED LIMIT** is 5 MPH for all campers safety, including bicycles.
- SITE PRICE** : Includes 2 people, one RV or tent and 2 vehicles. No vehicle washing.
- DO NOT ABUSE** or remove any park property or property of others. We are privileged to have ducks, quail and other wildlife in our park. Please do not disturb them.
- THE CREEK AND HILLSIDE** are not play areas and should be avoided. Sliding rocks, poison oak and ticks are a problem.
- CHILDREN** must be supervised at all times. This includes restrooms, showers and beach. No children are allowed to be left in the park without adult supervision. Parents are held responsible for damage or injury involving their children.
- PETS** are welcome at Westport. Limit of two dogs per site. California law requires all dogs to be leashed and so do we. You may be asked to leave without a refund after 1 warning: A) Your pet is not on a leash. B) Your pet leaves your campsite. C) Your pet is left alone D) You do not pick-up after your pet. And no warning if your pet causes injury. No vicious dogs of any kind are allowed.
- WETSUITS ARE ABSOLUTELY NOT ALLOWED** in the restrooms or showers.
- TRASH** is not to be put in the bushes, the creek or the fire rings. No burning plastic. Trash cans are placed throughout the park. **Do not leave broken chairs, air mattresses, tents and broken BBQ's. You will be charged \$25.**
- NO FISHING IN THE CREEK:** It is protected by California Fish & Wildlife.
- CAMPFIRES** are allowed in the fire rings or pits only.
- FIREARMS/FIREWORKS** are strictly forbidden. If you set off fireworks you will be asked to leave with no refund. This includes BB guns.
- PLEASE RECYCLE:** bins provided for cans, bottles, plastics. Crush all cans and plastics and breakdown cardboard boxes.
- Reservations must be cancelled two weeks prior to arrival or deposit is forfeited. No refunds for early departure. The remaining balance will be charged 24 hours prior to arrival. Non refundable.**
- SHOWERS** are coin operated. Quarters are available at the camp store.
- Cabins:** No smoking allowed. Any smoking, excessive trash or damage will incur a cleaning/repair fee.
- NO HOT TUBS.**
- EV Charging is Prohibited**
- Defrauding the Innkeeper** Any person who fails to accurately report the number of persons or pets with the intention of avoiding payment of fees, or who fails to pay the bill in full prior to departing Westport Beach RV Park is guilty of California Penal Code Section 537. Violators will be prosecuted to the fullest, with fines up to \$1,000 and/or one year in county jail.

Please Use Caution

- Wade and swim at your own risk.
- Beware of riptide area shown on the map.
- No motorized vehicles on beach at any time.
- Rising tides reach bluffs to north and south of campground beach.
- Use caution and watch tides when leaving campground beach.
- Beware of broken glass. Please wear tennis shoes in creek at all times.
- Like any natural area, beware of poison oak, wildlife, other hazards and check for ticks.

- Bears are very active.
- Don't feed the bears.
- Don't leave trash in site.
- Don't leave food out.
- Put ice chest in vehicle at night.
- Keep vehicle & RV doors shut.

Set up camp away from dense cover and natural food sources. Cook as far from your tent as possible. Do not store food, trash, clothes worn when cooking, or toiletries in your tent. Store in approved bear resistant containers OR out of sight in locked vehicle OR suspended at least 10 ft above the ground and 10 feet from any part of the tree.
