

GUIDELINES FOR A PLEASANT STAY

- How many **people** can stay on my site? There is a maximum of 6 people over the age of five total on any RV or tent site.
- How many **camping units** per site? Only one tent or camper is allowed.
- Can I pitch a **tent at a cabin or an RV site**? No, you will need to reserve a tent site.
- When is **check-in/check-out** time? For camping, the check-in/check-out time is 12 o'clock, noon. Camper cabins check-out is before 11 am. Housekeeping cabins, lodge rooms, and covered wagons check-in is after 3 pm and check-out is before 10 am. A stay beyond check-out time, without prior approval, is subject to an additional charge.
- Will I get a **refund** if I leave early? There are no refunds once you check-in. No exceptions for weather.
- What if I would like to **extend my stay**? Yes, we would like to have you stay longer. Just check with the office for availability.
- Does the resort have **quiet hours**? Yes, quiet hours are 10 pm to 8 am. Please respect your neighbors. No audible sound beyond your space. Generators are not allowed at any time.
- Who is the **responsible party**? The registered guest is responsible for the conduct of everyone in their party.
- Are **campfires** allowed? Yes, campfires are allowed in the designated fire rings or fire pits. Firewood must be inside the fire ring. No junk lumber, stumps, pallets, etc., are allowed. Any and all unattended fires **MUST** be extinguished before leaving.
- Where do I find **firewood**? Firewood is available for purchase at the store. Any cutting of trees, dead or alive, is strictly prohibited and subject to a fine.
- Am I responsible for **cleaning my campsite** before I leave? Yes, remove any trash and unburned firewood. Receptacles for trash are located near the restrooms.
- Are **pets** allowed? Pets are allowed at campsites but are **NOT** allowed in cabins, lodge rooms, wagons, or public buildings. Any evidence of pets in cabins, lodge rooms, wagons, or public buildings, is subject to a fine. Pets must be kept on a leash at all times, never left unattended, and you must clean up after them.
- What is a **safe speed to drive** on the resort property? The maximum speed limit is 10 MPH. We love our kids.
- Where can I **ride my ATV or UTV**? Riding ATVs or UTVs is prohibited on resort property. You can ride on Arapaho Forest designated trails.
- Where can I **wash my RV**? No vehicle washing is allowed on the resort. There is a vehicle washing business in Granby.
- Smoking**? All cabins, lodge rooms, and public buildings are **smoke free**.
- Marijuana use in any form is strictly prohibited on Winding River Resort property.**
- Can I fly **Drones**? Drone flying is prohibited on resort property and adjoining federal lands.
- Charging of electric vehicles is prohibited at campsite pedestals.**

OFF HIGHWAY VEHICLE GUIDELINES

(ATVs, Side By Sides, & Unlicensed Motorized Vehicles)

- ATVs, Side By Sides, and Unlicensed Motorized Vehicles **CANNOT** be used for general transportation on Winding River Resort property (e.g. to/from restrooms, office, store, barn, trash disposal or visiting other campsites).
- ATVs, Side By Sides and Unlicensed Motorized Vehicles may be ridden from your cabin or campsites to/from the trailhead **ONCE** per day.
- Gates to access the Arapaho National Forest are open from 8 am to 5 pm.
- Access for Winding River Resort Guests to the Arapaho National Forest is June 15th thru September 30th.
- Speed limit is 10 MPH.
- Access to the Arapaho National Forest trail system is prohibited on County Road 491 and County Road 492.
